I.CAMPSITE RULES

INTRODUCTION

BrigandZe Beach is a party, but not without rules. These are necessary for everything to run smoothly. So stick to them! If the campsite rules are not respected, access to the entire event may be denied. If the law is broken, the police will be notified. Remember that the organisation always has the last say.

ACCESS CAMPSITE BRIGANDZE BEACH

A camping ticket can be purchased in advance. Every user must have a valid camping ticket. Wild camping is not allowed.

OPENING HOURS CAMPSITE

The doors open on Friday at 18:00. Everyone has to leave the campsite by 18h00 on Sunday 10/07/2022. The campsite is open day and night.

CAR, MOBILE HOME, CARAVAN,...

Please note! Cars are not allowed on the campsite. Please leave your mobile home, caravan, etc. at home. The BrigandZe Beach organisation does not provide a campsite for mobile homes.

SAFETY

If you are caught committing violence, theft or vandalism, the police will be informed immediately and you will be removed from the premises!

THEFT

The entire campsite is under surveillance, but it is impossible to watch everyone's belongings. Leave as many valuables as possible at home and certainly do not leave valuables unattended in your tent. The organisation cannot be held responsible for loss/theft of personal items.

GLASS AND WEAPONS

Glass and weapons are prohibited on the entire campsite. Tins and plastic bottles are allowed. If you catapult all kinds of objects (not limited to glass and weapons) into the air, you will be removed from the premises immediately and denied further access to the event. If necessary, the organisation will also file a complaint with the competent authorities.

VANDALISM

Vandalism is not allowed. Please respect other people's property!

Climbing fences, toilets, tents, etc. is forbidden. Graffiti is not allowed either.

The organisation cannot be held responsible for damage to personal items. In case of damage to objects which were already present on the campsite (including but not limited to the fences, toilets, secretariat...), the vandal will be held accountable and will have to pay the damages.

FIRE

It is forbidden to make fire.

This means: no fires in open air (campfire), as well as barbecues, torches, candles, fireworks, as well as setting fire to your tent after the festival! For your own safety, keep fire lanes and emergency exits clear, otherwise your tent will be removed. Camping gas (blue cans) is allowed to a maximum of 1kg.

DOGS AND OTHER PETS

Animals are not allowed on the campsite. Dogs running loose will be caught and the owner will have to pay €125 to get the dog back. If the owner refuses, the dog will be transferred to a kennel. All costs related to this will also have to be paid by the owner.

NOISE

Noise nuisance is prohibited. Generators, vuvuzelas and music systems are not allowed. Think of your fellow campers who want to relax after a long day of rugby. In the event of noise nuisance, you are also at risk of being removed from the site.

TRADE

Campers are not allowed to trade under any circumstances. It is forbidden to sell food, drinks or anything else.

WASTE

The waste pile of a group of campers is enormous, so make use of the containers provided and the waste bag you will be given. Take your tent and other camping equipment with you when you go back home.

FACILITIES

The campsite is equipped with toilets, showers, running water and a secretariat.

LIQUOR, NARCOTICS AND/OR DRUGS

The use of narcotics and/or drugs is prohibited. In case of suspicion of use and/or sale, the police will be notified.

The possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages, not purchased at BrigandZe Beach, is prohibited on the campsite. This also applies to the adjacent areas such as the rugby pitches, festivity hall, stands, connecting roads, etc. There will be checks and any intercepted alcohol will be irrevocably confiscated.

The organisation does not allow:

- alcoholic beverages to people younger than 16,
- liquor to people aged between 16 and 18,
- alcoholic beverages to persons in a state of intoxication.

2. COMPETITION RULES

The competition rules of the IRB Beach Rugby shall apply.

TOURNAMENT:

From the semi-finals onwards, the team is composed of the same 12 players. After the semi-finals, max 2 injured players can be substituted. The team leader has to communicate this to the competition secretariat.

Group phase: ranking

Win = 4 points, draw = 2 points, loss = 0 points

In case of a tie or determination of the best successor after all pool matches are played, the criteria below are taken into account in the following order:

- Points gained / number of matches
- Least Red Cards
- Score balance / number of matches
- Number of tries / number of matches
- Heads or tails

Final rounds:

In the event of a draw at the end of the match, the next steps to determine the winner are shown below and are taken in following order:

- 5' minutes golden try
- From each team 1 attacker on the half way line against 1 defender on the tryline tries to score a try (attacker then becomes defender and vice versa). If the body or knee of the attacking player touches the ground, it means that they have not scored a try.
- Heads or tails.

If there are no 4 pools, the best successors will also go on to the final rounds

In case of discussion, the Tournament Directors are always right.

3. EVENT RULES

GENERAL

- Participation in the tournament and presence on our premises are entirely at your own risk. Both the organisation and people involved in the organisation can in no way be held responsible for physical or material damage.
- No alcohol under the age of 16.
- Use of own drinks and food on the tournament site is forbidden.
- Pets are not allowed on the tournament site.
- Urinating in public is punishable by law.
- Weapons of any kind are strictly prohibited.
- The organisation has a zero tolerance policy on drugs.

- Campfires, barbecues, torches and the like are strictly forbidden.
